

# Valentine Treat Boxes

Give a sweet gift in a handmade box of love.

**Crafter level:** Intermediate

**Crafter needed:** 10 minutes (per box)

## What you'll need

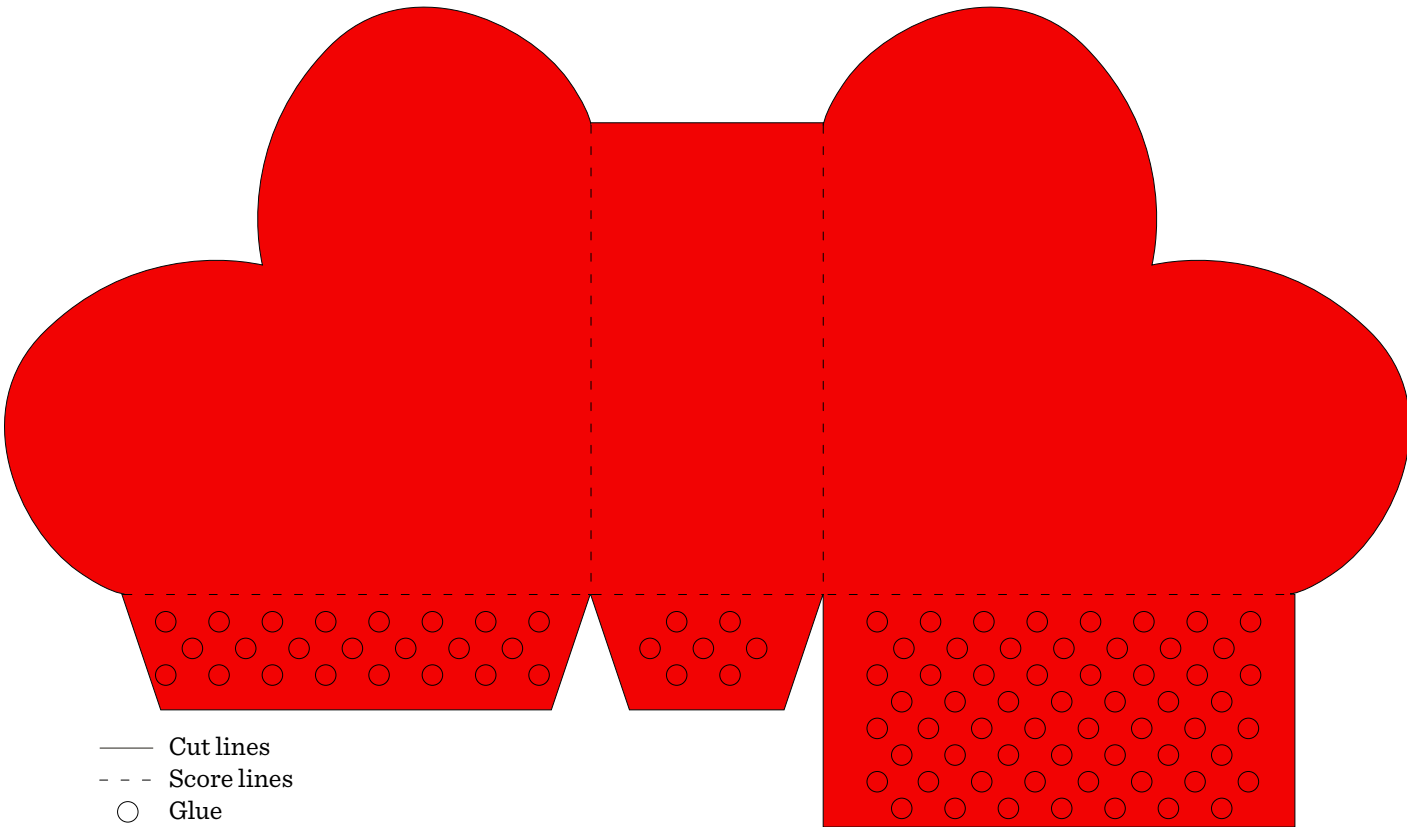
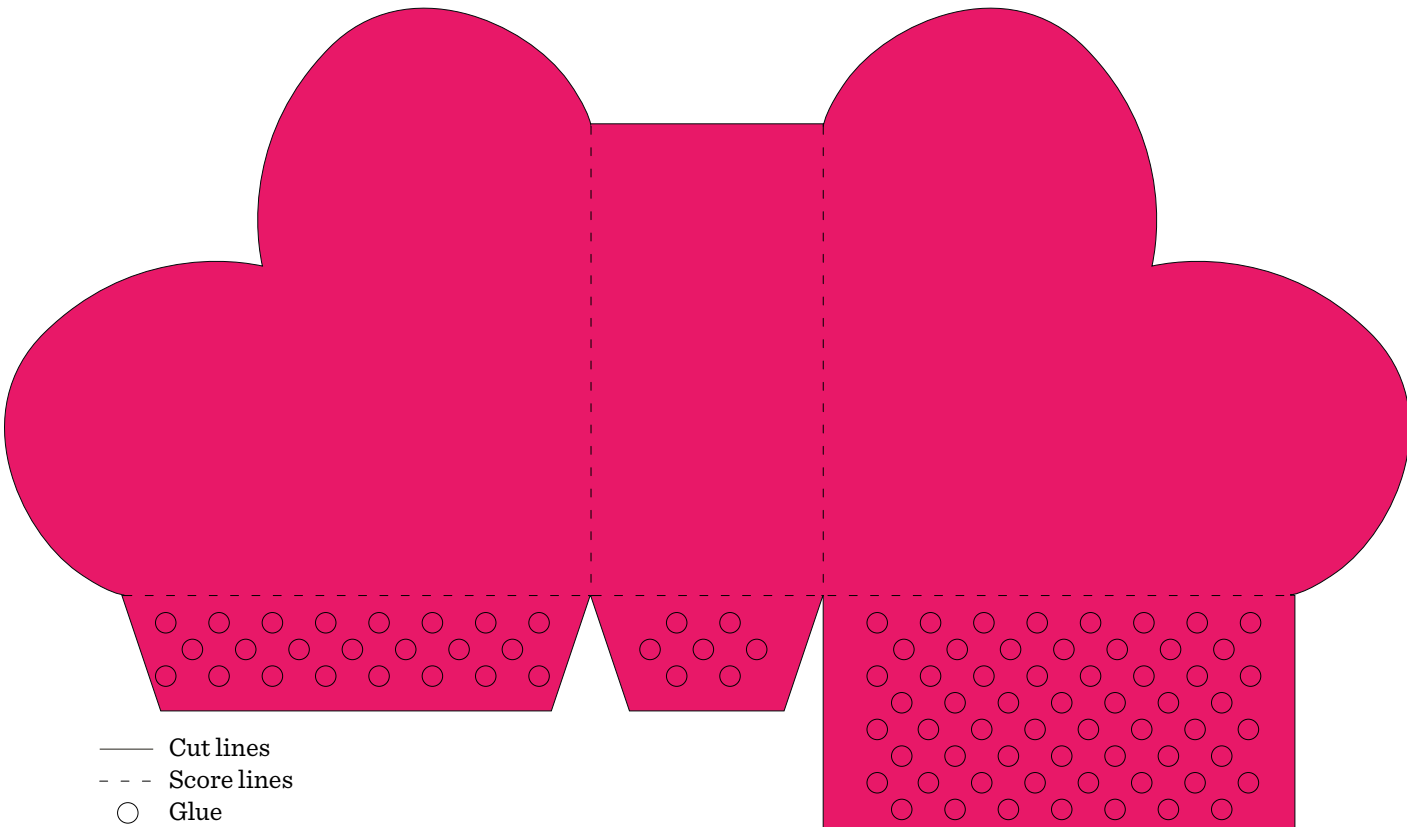
- Card stock weight paper
- Low-temp hot glue gun and glue sticks or double-sided tape
- Craft knife
- Cello bags for treats (optional)
- Ribbons for tying treats (optional)
- Gemstones (optional)



## How to make it

1. Print included templates on card stock weight paper. Cut out the templates you'd like to use.  
*Tip: Flip your craft knife blade over and use the dull side to lightly score down the score lines for a clean crisp fold.*
2. Use your low-temp hot glue gun and run a bead of glue down the flaps on the sides marked for glue. You can also use double-sided tape in place of the glue.
3. Now you are ready to add hearts and banners to create the front of your treat box. You can use the striped hearts or the solids.  
*Tip: You can add glitter over the solid hearts for an extra glitzy heart. You can also add gemstones or anything else you'd like to these.*
4. Add a cello bag of sweets with a fun ribbon to complete your treats.
